NON-INTERCHANGEABILITY OF GEARBOX GEARS

The following parts if, manufactured in Australia, <u>CANNOT</u> be used in conjunction with gears manufactured in England or vice versa. English gears are stamped with "MOWOG" only, whereas Australian gears are stamped with "MOWOG" over the map of Australia or "MOWOG-A".

11G 3064	2nd Speed Gear	Front face.
11G 3090	Reverse gear	Rear face.
1G 3594	3rd Speed Mainshaft Gear	Front face.
JG 3597	3rd and 4th Synchro	Front face.
1G 3598	Synchro coupling	Next to selector recess.
1G3610	1st Motion Shaft	To the rear of the splines.
48G137	(1st speed gear and (2nd Speed synchro	No stamping refer sketch. Front face.

* Serviced as an assembly only.

lst speed gear used in assembly Part No. 48G137 has no stamping, however the country of manufacture can be ascertained by referring to illustrations 'A' and 'B', and the stamping on the front face of 2nd speed synchro:


NOTE: - When ordering these parts the suffix A to the part number will denote Australian and Suffix E English.

Note internal tooth formation causing serrated appearance on top face.
